RESPONSIBILITY

1. Organize and oversee a growing student ministry that fits within our Family Ministry Strategy to support the total vision / strategic plan of Windsor Road Christian Church.
2. Pastor a shepherd a student ministry that leads students to enthusiastically put God first, love Him most, and demonstrate that love by loving others.
3. Provide regular opportunities (both in teaching and meetings) for students and their families to come to know Christ and respond to His life-changing message.
4. Recruit, train, disciple, and equip volunteer leaders to know Christ and use their gifts to share Him with students each week.
5. Continually keep Family Ministry Team, volunteers, and staff informed about ministry progress and plans.
6. Contribute to the cohesive family ministry plan of what children and students should look like spiritually at each stage of their walk with Christ.
7. Equip parents to shepherd the hearts of their teens and preteens
8. Assist in other areas of the church s directed by the Family Minister.
