Fruit of the Spirit: Faithfulness—Galatians 5:22-23

Week of 11.4.2019

Icebreaker: When you hear the word "faithfulness," what word, scripture, or song comes to mind?

HOW does Gal. 5:22-23 define Faithfulness?

The Greek word for Faithfulness is *pistis.* In his sermon, Randy discussed its 3 definitions.

- 1.) A body of beliefs; set of teachings.
 - "Beloved, although I was eager to write to you about our common salvation, I found it necessary to write appealing to you to contend for the faith that was once for all delivered to the saints." Jude 3 ESV
- 2.) Have confidence in; depend on; active trust.

 "Now it is evident that no one is justified before God by the law, for "The righteous shall live by faith." Gal. 3:11 ESV
- 3.) Faithfulness; trustworthiness; reliability, dependability.

 "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control..." Gal. 5:22 ESV

Randy said, "Faithfulness is Spirit-supplied consistency to long-term loyalty." Discuss the 2 parts of the definition. Can a person be one without the other?

WHY is faithfulness supernatural?

"Your steadfast love, O LORD, extends to the heavens, your faithfulness to the clouds." Psalm 36:5 ESV

"The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness." La. 3: 22-23 ESV

- Since faithfulness is a fruit of the spirit, does that mean that a non-believer cannot be faithful? Do you have a friend or family member (non-believer) who you can rely upon, trust? Can that person also be called faithful?

- If you feel the need/desire to increase your walk of faithfulness, would you consider specifically praying for the Holy Spirit to gift you with an extra measure of this fruit this week? Ask your group to also pray for you, if you desire.
- Individually, or as a group, read Rev. 19:11-16 aloud. What do you think and feel as you hear these verses, especially verse 11?
